The student should meet with the DGS to discuss his/her program of study and academic history to determine if a course overload is advisable. The student must complete the form below, obtain the signature of the DGS and submit the form to gradacademics@duke.edu or to the Graduate School, 2127 Campus Drive, no later than two business days before the conclusion of the drop/add period. If approved, the student's credit limit will be raised, and the student will be notified to add the course to his/her schedule in DukeHub before the end of the drop/add period.
